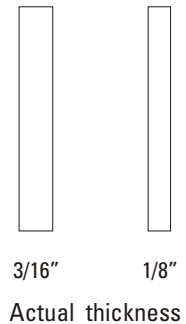


# mounting substrates

## Onyx Foam Core

Our Onyx Foam Core is an effective way to make a Pro Print rigid. It is most practically used for short amounts of time and in a low-traffic area. There is a greater chance that the corners or edges of the material can be damaged because foam core is a softer mounting substrate than the other materials.

## Gatorboard

Gatorboard is a stronger material than foam core and durable enough for moderate to high-traffic areas. This sturdy material is an ideal surface for displaying Pro Prints. Using 1/2" gatorboard to produce a double-sided mount with grommets is a very professional look and a great way to display images in a retail setting.

## Sintra
